When you do the 30 Hour Famine, you're opening your eyes to the reality of global poverty. The funds you raise will bring hope to hungry kids: your brothers and sisters in the family of God.

Fundraising ideas

» Create your team fundraising page—and go viral.

Find your team and create your fundraising page at **famine.ca**. Make it your own with your photo and story—now's the chance to let people know why you're choosing to do the Famine. Then, ask friends and family to fund your Famine using your favorite social platforms. Try making a short video or two you can share with your squad (or email to your grandma) for a more personal ask. When you share the link, don't forget to tag #30hourfamine.

» Lend a hand.

Go around your neighborhood offering to do yardwork or chores at neighbors' houses in exchange for a donation. This is a great way to spread the word about the Famine outside the church.

Make the fundraising fun

Aim for a minimum of \$240—feeds four hungry families for a year—as your fundraising goal. If you did the Famine last year, challenge yourself to double your previous amount!

\$60

feeds a hungry family for a **year!**

\$240

feeds four hungry families for a **year!**

\$480

feeds eight hungry families for a **year!**

Here's your handy script for asking friends and family for donations—on the phone or IRL.

"Hi _____, this is ____

I'm really excited to be doing World Vision's 30 Hour Famine. I'm giving up food for 30 hours to raise money to help hungry kids around the world.

During our Famine event we'll learn about global hunger and poverty—and get a glimpse of how it feels to be hungry. Every day over 7,000 kids die from hungerrelated causes. But, just \$60 feeds a hungry family for a year. Would you be willing to donate \$120 to help feed two families for a whole year?"

» Pro tip: Don't be afraid of the "awkward silence."

- **If they decline**, try offering one tier lower:
- "I understand. \$120 can be a lot. Would you consider \$60 to help feed a hungry family for a year?"
- If they decline again, try one more time:
- "Can I tell you a little bit about World Vision? They're a Christian humanitarian organization, and they've been helping kids and families break free from poverty for almost 70 years. So you can be sure your donation is going to programs that help kids who really need it. Will you consider \$60 to help feed a hungry family for a year?"
- If they agree to support you:
- "Thank you! You can make your cheque out to World Vision Canada. And your donation is tax-deductable too! Your tax receipt will be provided closer to tax time."



- If they decline to support you:
- "I understand. Thanks for your time. I would love it if you'd join me in prayer for hungry kids around the world and for my group as we do this event."
- If you're leaving a voicemail, use this shorter script:
- "Hi _____, this is __

I'm excited to be doing World Vision's 30 Hour Famine to raise money for kids who go hungry around the world. Every day, over 7,000 kids die from hunger-related causes, and just \$60 helps feed a hungry family for a year. I'm sorry I missed you today, but I'll call again to tell you more. I would really appreciate your support. Thank you, _____!"
